Treasurers report \$193,052.78 in all accounts with the general fund having \$172,409.60

Motion to yield the voting allocation of \$34.18 to Pine County for election expenses in 2025 & 2026 by Tim Johnsen, 2nd by Darryl Herzog.

Motion to upgrade quickbooks to a new version by Tim Johnsen, 2nd by Darryl Herzog.

Motion to pay bills by Tim Johnsen, 2nd by Darryl Herzog.
