ORDINANCE NO. 2017-4

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE KEEPING OF HOUSES OF ILL FAME AND DISORDERLY HOUSES THE CITY OF RUTLEDGE, MN

The City Council of the City of Rutledge do ordain as follows:

Section I- Any person or persons who shall, within the corporate limits of the City of Rutledge, keep a house of ill fame or assignation of any description, or a house or place for persons to visit for unlawful sexual intercourse, or for any other lewd, obscene or indecent purposes, or who shall keep a disorderly or ill-governed house or place, or any place of public resort by which the peace, comfort or decency of a neighborhood is habitually disturbed, or who as agent or owner lets a building, or any portion of a building, or any place, knowing that it is intended to be used for any purposes specified in this section, or who permits a building or a portion of a building, or any place to be so used, and all persons male or female, who resort to or frequents such disorderly house, or place or house of ill-fame shall be guilty and sentenced in accordance with presiding authority to the fullest extent of the law, provided proof of general reputation of ill-fame and disorderly conduct shall be sufficient evidence that such house is a house of ill-fame, or a place of disorderly conduct, within the meaning of this ordinance.

Section II.- This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after passage and publication.
